

Fuel Saving Tips



Avoid High Speeds

As your speed increases, your aerodynamic drag increases



Use A/C Sparingly

Air conditioner use results in increased fuel consumption



Keep Tires Properly Inflated

Keep tire air pressure at the recommended level



Do Not Accelerate or Brake Hard

Increase fuel economy by as much as 20%



Keep Windows Closed

Windows open increase drag and result in decreased fuel economy



Service Vehicle Regularly

Proper maintenance avoids poor fuel economy related to dirty air levels.



Use Cruise Control

Maintaining a constant speed over long distances



Avoid Heavy Loads

Remove excess items from your trunk and pack lightly for long trips.



Avoid Long Idles

Restarting the engine uses less fuel than letting it idle



Purchase a Fuel Efficient Vehicle

a small vehicle with a manual transmission will provide you with better fuel economy.
